For the first three months in this position I served in the department's community public relations office assisting with the DARE program. During my time as a detective I was responsible for the investigation of numerous and varied crimes and the filing of cases for prosecution. I testified in court on many cases and often served as the investigating officer (I.O.) assisting the prosecuting District Attorney.

In addition to assisting in the investigations of traffic collisions, I also served as the department expert in the area of mechanical condition of vehicles involved in traffic collisions. This included conducting test drives, skid tests and mechanical inspections of these vehicles and then reporting on my findings. Many of the traffic collisions that I have assisted in have included major injuries and / or fatalities.
